Application For Vehicle/Guest Pass Registration-Parking Stickers
COVID -19 UPDATE IAW Gov. Baker's Emergency Order enacted Mar 10, 2020



Sherwood Forest lakes, beaches and roads are private for the exclusive use of Sherwood Forest Lake District proprietors and their guests.

All vehicles parked at any of the District's beaches or on the roads adjacent to the beaches must display a SFLD registration-parking sticker. Registration-parking stickers allow official authorities to easily identify vehicle without registration-parking stickers that may not be authorized to park on SFLD beach property or along the adjacent roads. This simply increases security and peace of mind for those utilizing our community's private beaches. Parking on private property is not affected in any way and does not require a SFLD registration-parking sticker.

Up to two vehicle stickers for use on vehicles registered to the deeded owners and one guest pass **may** be issued by the district's authorized registrar for each **SFLD** taxable parcel owned. Any application for an additional vehicle registration-parking sticker because of extenuating circumstances requires a proprietor to attend a regularly scheduled monthly meeting of the SFLD's Prudential Committee to make the request, or call the district's **teleconference number (1) 623 600 3763 and enter ACCESS CODE 114253**. Prudential Committee meetings are generally held on the second Saturday every month at 10:00 AM at the Becket Town Hall. The official schedule is posted on the SFLD's website at www.sfldbecket.org or individuals may call the SFLD's clerk at 413-281-6396.

Request for Vehicle Registration-Parking Sticker(s) or Guest Pass must include:

- **Lake District Tax Bill showing the parcel's ID and street address**
- **Current photocopy of each vehicle's registration certificate**

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Guest Pass: A single Guest Registration-parking sticker will be issued as follows:

1. Sherwood Forest House number plus street name will be entered on the sticker
2. If no town approved dwelling exists the SF street name plus the Map & Lot number will be entered

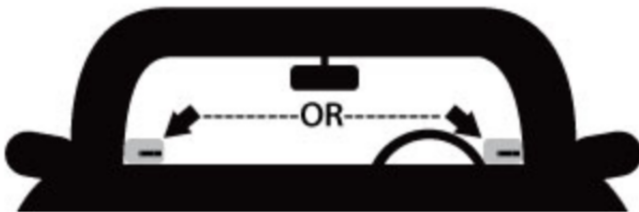

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STICKER PLACEMENT

Vehicle Registration-Parking stickers Your permit decal must be properly displayed on your vehicle windshield while parked at the community beaches or on district roads. Affix the decal to the inside front windshield in the lower left or lower right corner as shown below in compliance with the appropriate stated registry rules. The entire permit must be clearly visible.



Motorcycle Registration-Parking stickers Your permit decal must be properly displayed on your vehicle in a conspicuous spot. The entire permit must be clearly visible.

Guest Pass Registration-Parking sticker will be issued in a protective clear vinyl sleeve, which is designed to be hung from the vehicle's interior center rear view mirror when parking at a beach. Vehicles displaying permits in this manner should remain locked to prevent theft. Motorcyclists should not leave a guest pass with the vehicle, but must have it available for inspection when parking at a beach.

Note:

1. The District will only issue a free replacement vehicle registration-parking sticker if the proprietor replaces a vehicle and scrapes off and turns in the original sticker (It does not need to be intact). If the vehicle is totally destroyed or stolen a copy of the police report will be sufficient evidence to get a new sticker and if the vehicle's windshield is replaced a copy of the receipt from the installer.
2. It behooves everyone to be very diligent and safeguard the Guest Pass Registration-parking stickers. Guest Pass Registration-stickers which are lost for any reason will be replaced according to the following schedule: Proprietors will be charged twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first replacement sticker, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a second replacement sticker and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) dollars for each subsequent replacement sticker.
3. Registration-Parking stickers remain the property of the District. They are issued by the district registrar to proprietors and remain valid indefinitely until the proprietor no longer owns property within the District. Any alteration, misuse, duplication or use of a lost or stolen permit may result in confiscation of the permit and a substantial fine.
